

What we do to protect our exhibitors & information on non-exhibiting suppliers.

POLICY

Suppliers that have not purchased exhibit space will not be allowed to attend the Expo.

This is done out of respect for our exhibiting companies, as well as for the protection and security of our exhibitors.

REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS

Individuals not approved to be at the Expo and/or anyone violating the rules will be asked to leave the convention center.

To protect the sales of your products and services, we ask that you contact show management immediately if you see someone violating these rules.

Please report any suspicious activity to any Expo staff member in the Information Booth #602.

THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE:

If a supplier is part of an exhibiting company's booth, and will be working that booth, they will be allowed on the show floor as an exhibitor.

Companies who are scouting out the Expo for consideration of exhibiting in 2012 may be pre-authorized to attend. They will be assigned a specific time to walk the show floor escorted by an Expo staff member. They will be forbidden from soliciting business at the Expo, including the distribution of sales literature, samples and business cards.

Non-exhibiting suppliers and children under 16 years of age (including infants) will not be permitted access to the exhibit floor at any time. This INCLUDES move-in and move-out hours.
